Safety Protocols for 2020 Opening

- **Covid- 19 Safety Protocols will be updated throughout the summer according to the CDC, the Department of Health and NYS Authorities. Protocols will be changed as needed.**
- **The Safety of our Guests and Staff is our First Priority!**

- **All guests are required to sign in and sign out when arriving and leaving the property.**
